Contempt of Court Case (C) No.1201 of 2025

JUDGMENT

This Contempt of Court Case is instituted at the instance of the petitioners in OP(C) No.1187 of 2025, contending that the respondents have violated the directions in the judgment dated 21.05.2025. The operative portion of the directions in the judgment dated 21.05.2025 reads as under:-

“Accordingly, this petition is allowed in part.

i. The trial Court, Commercial Court, Ernakulam is directed to dispose of the matter in I.A.No.9/2025 in CS No.118 of 2024 within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

ii. Meanwhile, the respondents are restrained from alienating the properties in par, the sale notice has been stayed until disposal of the interlocutory application, I.A.No.9/2025 by the trial Court.”

2. It is an admitted fact that the challenge to the judgment was taken before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and by judgment dated

27.05.2025, the Supreme Court set aside the judgment with a direction to this Court to rehear the Original Petition since the judgment was rendered as ex-parte. The dispute, now, presented before this Court centers around the alleged sale of intangible property. However, the petitioners dispute the said fact and contend that there are two entities out of which the property of one entity is a virtual property and that of the another is tangible property.

3. Be that as it may, it is admitted across the bar that the properties of these two entities, namely Epic Creations INC and Tangible Play INC were subjected to an involuntary sale by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. The further question in this Contempt of Court Case is whether the directions contained in the judgment dated 21.05.2025 would bind the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, US.

4. Noticing the fact that the Judgment dated 21-5-2025 stands set aside by the Supreme Court on 27-5-2025, this Court by order dated 18.03.2026 was of the prima facie view that nothing remains to be considered in the contempt proceedings. But then, the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the alleged violation took place when

the Court's directions were operative, i.e. between the dates of judgment of this Court and the subsequent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and thus, the contempt would still be maintainable for the disobedience.

5. According to the learned counsel appearing for the 7th respondent, the alleged sale took place on 20.05.2025, whereas according to the petitioners, the sale was held on 27.05.2025. It is also pertinent to mention that, on 04.06.2025, this Court had finally disposed of the Original Petition in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, holding that the original petition has become infructuous leaving liberty to the petitioners to approach the Court for appropriate remedy.

6. A perusal of the judgment dated 04.06.2025 shows that this Court has taken note of the fact that the sale took place on 20.05.2025, which is not seen disputed by the petitioners when the Original Petition was finally disposed of. It is also brought to the notice of this Court that I.A.No.9/2025 was subsequently dismissed as infructuous on 03.07.2025. There again, the petitioners had no dispute with regard to the factum of sale i.e., on 20.05.2025. That be so, this Court is of the



view that the present dispute raised by the petitioners regarding the date of sale i.e., on 27.05.2025, is raised only to keep the contempt alive in order to achieve a particular desired result.

7. The learned counsel for the petitioners however asserted that, by Annexure C order, the entire proceedings of the sale were ultimately closed on 27.05.2025 and therefore, there is a deliberate disobedience of the directions of this Court.

8. On an anxious consideration of the submissions, this Court is unable to accept the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners, especially since by the time the proceedings dated 27.05.2025 was issued by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, US, the judgment of this Court was set aside by the Supreme Court.

9. At any rate, the petitioners had no case that the respondents were properly intimated with regard to the interdictory order passed by this Court. Moreover, going by the averments in the contempt petition, the petitioners themselves have conceded that the steps for sale commenced as early as on 18-5-2025. Therefore, viewed in the totality of the circumstances, this Court is not inclined to



proceed with this Contempt of Court Case. That apart, despite this Court pointing out the infirmities in the Contempt of Court Case, still the learned counsel for the petitioners insisted that the proceedings be continued because there is a deliberate violation of the order passed by this Court.

10. Moreover, even if this Court had interdicted the respondents from proceeding with the sale, obviously the said interdiction will not be applicable to a judicial proceedings taken by a court of competent jurisdiction outside the territory of India/Kerala especially when the respondents have no notice regarding the judgment. That be so, this Court is of the view that by prosecuting the Contempt of Court Case, the petitioners, in fact, have wasted the precious judicial time of this Court.

Accordingly, this Contempt of Court Case is dismissed with an exemplary cost of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) to be paid by the petitioners to the Kerala High Court Legal Services Committee within a period of ten days from date of receipt of the copy of the judgment, failing which the High Court Legal Services Committee is empowered to recover with due process of law.
