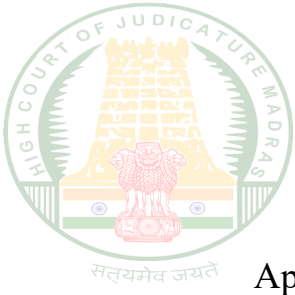

COMMON ORDER

Applicant is the rightful certificate holder from Central Board of Film Certification [CBFC] for the teaser of the film “HAI JAWANI TOH ISHQ HONA HAI” and also for the audio visual songs of the said film. The said certificates dated 02.04.2026 and 16.04.2026 have been exhibited as documents along with the suit. Taking cue about the release of the film on 22.05.2026, the applicant/plaintiff apprehends that the respondents/defendants are attempting to broadcast the movie without any proper license. *Prima facie*, the applicant/plaintiff has established to be the owner of the copyright of the subject film and he has specifically averred that he has not granted any license to any of the operators, including the respondents herein, except for theatrical rights of the said film.

2. In view of the above, if interim injunction is not granted as prayed for restraining the respondents from infringing the applicant’s copyright pending disposal of the suit, the applicant/plaintiff would be put to serious and irreparable hardship, including financial losses. I am satisfied that the applicant has made out a *prima facie* case for grant of interim order as prayed for. The balance of convenience is also in favour of the applicant only. In view of the above, there shall be an order of interim injunction as prayed for.

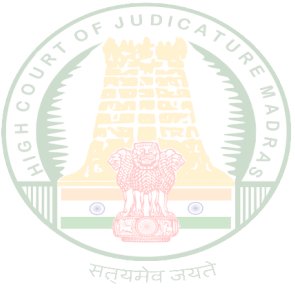
