1. The present petition has been filed seeking execution of order dated 13.03.2026 passed by the High Court of Justice, King's Bench Division, Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Commercial Court.
2. Issue notice.
3. Mr. K.R. Sasiprabhu, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the judgment debtor accepts notice.
4. Reply/objection be filed within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder/response thereto be filed before the next date of hearing.
5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the judgment debtor, on



instructions, submits that, without prejudice to its rights and contentions, an affidavit disclosing list of assets will be filed by the judgment debtor, in a sealed cover, within a period of three weeks. Let needful be done as undertaken.

6. Re-notify on 29.07.2026.
