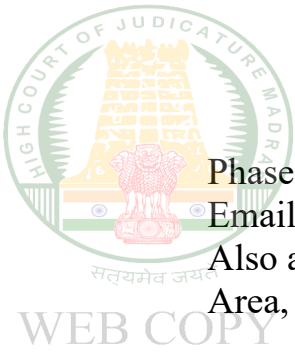

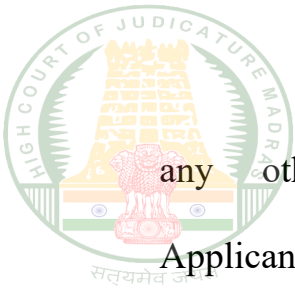

Original Application in O.A.No.725 of 2026 has been filed to grant an ad interim injunction, restraining the Respondents/Defendants, his associates, affiliates, partners, their employees, officers, servants, agents and all others acting for and on his behalf from manufacturing, selling, stocking, distributing, exporting, promoting, advertising, offering for sale, any products, websites, domain names, social media platforms, email address, mobile applications trade/corporate name and in any other manner directly or indirectly online or offline, dealing with any goods or services under the impugned mark ORG-9 or

4. Heard Mr.MS.Bharath, learned counsel for the applicant.

5. Considering the fact that the applicant is the registered trademark holder of a pharmaceutical product and the respondent, who is also a



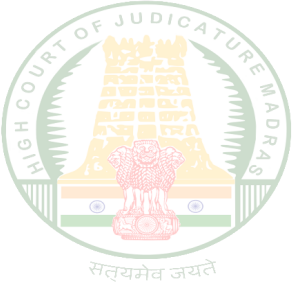
manufacturer of a similar product with a trademark “ORG-9”, as compared to the registered trademark of the applicant namely “ARG-9”, which is alpha-numeric and also considering the fact that, in a similar situation, while dealing with the issue, this Court, by its order dated 07.01.2026 in O.A.Nos.740 to 742 of 2025, had found that the alpha-numeric mark, namely “URG-9”, was *prima facie* infringing the trademark of the applicant, this Court is also *prima facie* convinced that there has been an infringement of the trademark of the applicant and accordingly, there shall be an order of injunction as prayed for.

6. Notice to the respondents returnable in four (4) weeks. Private Notice is permitted through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due.

7. List the matter after four (4) weeks.
