Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court notes the nature of the dispute and that in a similar case already an arbitrator has been appointed. Although, this Court has given time to the respondents to file reply, however, the same has not yet been filed.

Let the respondents file a reply before the Arbitrator.

Having noticed that in similar matter of dispute, the Arbitrator was already appointed by the Court, accordingly, this Court appoints Hon'ble Mr. Justice Arun Mishra, Former Chief Justice, Rajasthan High Court and Former Judge, Supreme Court of India, R/o 13, Akbar Road, New Delhi to act as the Sole Arbitrator and to decide all issues without prejudice to the rights and contentions raised in the present application and in the reply. The arbitration fees shall be determined in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Act of 1996, as amended. The fee of the Arbitrator will be equally borne by both the parties.
