UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Tushar Mehta, the learned Solicitor General, Dr. Abhishek Manu Singhvi and Mr. Amit Sibal the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and on the other hand, Mr. Ritin Rai, the learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent no.1.
2. We need to closely look into the matter.
3. Issue notice, returnable on 10.09.2026.
4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.
5. In the course of today's hearing, the learned Solicitor General handed over a demand draft of the award amount along with interest, of Rs.1,05,50,058/- (Rupees One Crore Five Lakh Fifty Thousand Fifty Eight only) drawn in favour of the respondent no.1, namely, Daksha Narendra Bhavsar. The possession of the demand draft has been taken over by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.1.
6. We reserve the liberty for the petitioner to recover the draft amount from the respondent no.2 subject to the final outcome of the present litigation.
7. In the meantime, the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court shall remain stayed from its operation.
